


#### II. DECK FITTINGS

- Ballast

- Exotic wood external woodwork
- Non slip paint on horizontal surfaces
- Anodised bow-plate with double bow roller
- Painted aluminium toerails
- Self-draining chain locker
- Horizontal electric windlass 1000W, Ø10 chain gypsy and drum
- Stainless steel Swedish-style anchor pulpit, LED port and starboard navigation lights
- Stainless steel aft pulpit in 3 sections with horseshoe buoy bracket, helm seat and exotic wood outboard engine bracket
- Sheathed double lifelines on s/s stanchions and side opening gates
- 2 bow mooring cleats 330 mm
- 2 stern mooring cleats 330 mm
- 2 midship spring cleats 330 mm
- 1 260 mm cleat with stern rollers on starboard side
- Anodised aluminium chain-plates with s/s bushes
- 1 fore cabin hatch (575x575) with curtain on rail
- 2 saloon hatches (525x395) with curtains on rails
- 1 galley/1 heads hatch (415x275) with curtains on rails
- 2 coaming hatches (415x275) in heads and aft cabin with curtains on rails
- 5 fixed hull portholes (500x220) with curtains on rails (6 in 3 cabin version)
- 2 Plexiglas coachroof coaming windows with curtains on rail
- 1 opening porthole in the cockpit (350x170) per aft cabin with curtain on rail
- 1 self-supporting mainsheet track, adjustable traveller with tackle
- 2 genoa/staysail sheet tracks with 4 piston adjustable traveller cars
- 2 locking winch handles



- 2 48 AST genoa sheet winches
- 2 30 AST halyard winches on coachroof
- 2 sheave boxes (x6) leading halyards and reefs back to the cockpit
- 7+6 jammers / cleats on coachroof for mainsheet, halyards and travellers, reef and centreboard manoeuvring lines
- 4 grab rails welded on coachroof
- Water, fuel, black water deck fillers
- Bathing platform hot and cold water shower
- Engine ventilation grill on bathing platform
- Bathing platform with s/s ladder and liferaft storage
- 2 harness attachment points (companionway and helm station)
- Aft arch for accessories with LED stern light and 2 attachment points for lifting dinghy
- Block + fairleads with jammer / cleat for genoa furler line

#### III. RIGGING

- Anodised aluminium deck stepped mast, double swept aft spreaders, 4 folding mast steps to reach the Main Sail
- Anodised aluminium boom fitted with outhaul and 3 reef lines leading back to cockpit
- LED mooring and masthead navigation lamps, halogen deck floodlight
- Mast step/pod with 9 blocks
- Genoa furling system
- 1 Rigid boom vang with tackle
- S/s standing fractional rigging:
  - 1 forestay
  - 1 removable inner forestay
  - 2 backstays (optional: 1 backstay insulated)
  - 2 upper shrouds
  - 2 inter shrouds
  - 2 aft lower shrouds
  - 2 running backstays
- Running rigging
  - 1 mainsail halyard
  - 1 genoa halyard
  - 1 staysail halyard
  - 1 boom topping lift
  - 2 genoa sheets + 2 staysail sheets + 1 Main Sail sheet

#### IV. SAILS

- Dacron cross-cut mainsail, 3 reefs, bag and battens
- Furling Dacron cross-cut genoa, bag
- Cross cut Dacron staysail on snap hook, bag

#### V. COCKPIT

- Large self-draining cockpit
- Slatted exotic wood bench seats, cockpit floor in synthetic teak
- Coaming compartments with aft cabins ventilation
- Aluminium head for tiller, aluminium rudderstock
- Emergency tiller
- Leather-wrapped Ø1000 steering wheel, compass, compass cover, stainless steel hoop / hand rail, engine control and display
- 2 watertight lockers on bathing platform, out of which 1 for gas bottle
- 2 watertight cockpit lockers with restraint, manual bilge pump
- 1 opening porthole in the cockpit per aft cabin



#### VI. COMPANIONWAY

- Smoked altuglass sliding companionway hatch
- Smoked altuglass companionway door in 2 sections with vents and stainless steel lock
- Storage for the companionway door
- Exotic wood door frame
- 2 s/s leather wrapped grab rails
- Solid wood non-slip companionway steps
- Removable companionway steps to access engine
- Headroom: 1.98 m

#### VII. NAVIGATION STATION

- Chart table with chart storage
- Slatted navigator's seat with storage beneath
- Bookshelf and storage
- Electric control panel with 10 functions at 12V, 5 functions at 220V, 1 220V socket, 1 USB socket, leak meter, water and fuel gauge
- Panel with pre cabling to install electronic instruments
- 1 adjustable chart reading light + 1 LED spotlight

#### VIII. SALOON

- Port side L-shaped settee and settee opposite
- Storage space under seating
- Large table with 2 flaps on centreboard case, optional double berth conversion
- Upholstered foam cushions, 12 cm thick + backrests
- Shelf behind seating with storage space
- Bookshelves to port and starboard sides
- Upholstered lining on ceiling and wood on hull sides
- Teak and holly laminate or dark wengé flooring
- Ventilation by 2 saloon hatches (525x395) with curtains on rails
- 2 fixed hull portholes (500x220) with curtains on rails
- 2 plexiglas coachroof coaming windows with curtains on rails
- 5 LED spotlights
- Aluminium mast support
- Headroom: 1.98 m

#### IX. GALLEY

- L-shaped galley
- White laminate worktop with solid wood fiddles
- Built-in s/s double bowl sink
- Pressurised hot and cold-water
- Seawater foot pump
- Gimballed s/s two-burner stove with oven with s/s protection rail
- 12V top opening refrigerator, 180 L
- Storage cupboard under sink
- 2 door crockery storage with 2 shelves
- Shelf behind the stove with bottle storage
- Ventilation through opening deck hatch (415x275) with curtain on rail
- Plexiglas coachroof coaming window with curtain on rail
- 2 LED spotlights, 1 220V socket
- Headroom: 1.98 m



## X. FORWARD CABIN (Standard)

- 1 double berth 200x200/80 cm at the feet
- 12 cm thick upholstered mattress
- Large storage lockers under berth
- Ventilated hanging locker with door
- Storage locker with door
- Locking sliding door separating cabin from saloon with retaining hook
- Teak and holly laminate or dark wengé flooring
- Upholstered lining on ceiling and wood on hull sides
- Ventilation through opening deck hatch (575x575) with curtain on rail
- 2 fixed hull portholes (500x220) with curtains on rails
- 1 LED spotlight, 2 adjustable LED reading lights, 1 USB socket
- Headroom: 1.85 m

# XI. AFT PORT CABIN (Standard)

- 1 double berth 200x195/145 cm at the feet
- 12 cm thick upholstered mattress
- Storage under berth
- Storage locker with hanging locker with door
- Locking door separating cabin from saloon with retaining hook
- Inspection hatch to engine
- Teak and holly laminate or dark wengé flooring
- Upholstered lining on ceiling and wood on hull sides
- Ventilation by opening porthole on coachroof (≅415x275) and cockpit (≅350x170) with curtain on rail
- 1 fixed hull porthole (500x220) with curtain on rail
- 1 spotlight, 2 LED adjustable reading lights
- Electric circuit breaker on berth front
- Headroom: 1.90 m

## XII. AFT CABINS (Option 3 cabin version)

- 1 double berth 200x150/100 cm at the feet
- 12 cm thick upholstered mattress
- Storage under berth
- Storage locker with hanging locker with door
- Locking door separating cabin from saloon with retaining hook
- Inspection hatch to engine
- Teak and holly laminate or dark wengé flooring
- Upholstered lining on ceiling and wood on hull sides
- Ventilation by opening porthole on coachroof (415x275) and cockpit (350x170) with curtain on rail
- 1 fixed hull porthole (500x220) with curtain on rail
- 1 LED spotlight, 2 LED adjustable reading lights
- Electric circuit breaker on port berth front
- Headroom: 1.90 m

# XIII. AFT HEAD-SHOWER COMPARTMENT (Standard)

- Locking door separating cabin from saloon
- White laminate bulkheads
- Storage locker, wet locker
- White laminate worktop, cabinet behind the washbasin, mirror, bassin
- Inspection hatch to engine
- Exotic wood shower grating



- Manuel pump toilet, plastic holding tank (55L)
- Washbasin + hot and cold pressurised, combined tap/shower head
- 1 electric shower discharge pump
- Ventilation by opening porthole on coachroof (415x275)
- 2 LED spotlights
- Door to aft locker

## XIV. AFT STORAGE LOCKER (Standard)

- Storage locker located starboard of companionway (accessed via heads compartment and from cockpit)
- Door to heads compartment
- Teak and holly laminate or dark wengé flooring
- 2 LED spotlights
- Aft storage locker layout on option (2 cabin version)

## XV. MECHANICS - ELECTRICITY

- Volvo D2-50 shaft drive, 50 hp two-pole insulated diesel engine
- Ø30 s/s shaft with Volvo rotary shaft seal and RH 17x16 fixed three blade propeller, sacrificial anode
- Soundproof ventilated engine compartment
- 2 AGM service batteries ≅90Ah + 1 engine battery ≅90 Ah
- 40A Battery charger and 120A load distributor
- 22 I water heater, 220V supply and via engine heat exchanger
- 1 automatic electric bilge pump with switch on control panel

#### I. CENTREBOARD AND RUDDER

- Tackle for centreboard lifting and lowering
- Hydraulic ram for rudder blade with manual pump in the aft cockpit locker
- Safety release valve in case rudder grounds
